### **S.3 HISTORY**

#### **SECTION A**

##### **Item 1**

For 20 years, people have been migrating to Uganda and settling in different parts of the country including your home area. During their continued coming, the local people (Natives) lack information about why these people keep on moving away from their countries and settle in your area. Therefore, they want them to be evicted away with an immediate effect. This has forced the local authorities of you are to sensitize the natives about the reasons for their coming. #### **SECTION B**

##### **Item 3.**

They mention various forms of exploitation, lack of commitment and outright brutalities against the people of East Africa as the root cause of the under development. To some people colonies set the foundation on which East Africa was able to develop like other former European colonies in Asia and Latin America. A public seminar has been organized in your sub-country to celebrate the 65<sup>th</sup> independence anniversary of your country and you have been invited to make a speech.

Giving relevant examples, prepare a speech to explain whether colonial rule contributed to modern development of East Africa or not.

### **Item 4**

During the insurgency in northern Uganda, Otim and his peers were abdicated by the rebels and taken into rebel camps and trained to fight the government while Joyce and Catherine were used to provide labour to the rebel commanders. As rebels they killed and looted items in the village. They performed these tasks without question to avoid being killed by the senior officers. They served as target of terror against their families and communities for all the time they spent. Otim later escaped from rebel captivity back home and he has suffered poverty and stigmatization.

- (a) As a human right fighter, identify the human rights that were abused for Otim and the people of his village.
- (b) As a student of history and political education, write an easy pointing out ways how the government can avoid such conflicts.
